

**THOMAS WILKINS** is music director of the Omaha Symphony and principal guest conductor of the Hollywood Bowl Orchestra. Past positions have included resident conductor of the Detroit Symphony and Florida Orchestra and associate conductor of the Richmond Symphony. He served on the music faculties of North Park University in Chicago, University of Tennessee in Chattanooga and Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond.

Wilkins has been a guest conductor with the Cleveland, Philadelphia and Louisville Orchestras; Boston, Dallas, Baltimore, Houston, Grand Rapids, Indianapolis, San Antonio, San Diego, Utah, Oregon and National Symphonies and Rochester and Buffalo Philharmonics, among others.

Wilkins serves as a director at large for the Greater Omaha Chamber of Commerce and has served on the board of directors of such organizations as St. Petersburg's Museum of Fine Arts and Academy Preparatory Center for Education.

A native of Norfolk, Virginia, Wilkins earned his Bachelor of Music Education degree from the Shenandoah Conservatory of Music and a Master of Music degree in Orchestral Conducting from Boston's New England Conservatory of Music.
