

For almost two decades, **MARC KUDISCH** has been one of the busiest actors in New York City. On Broadway, he was most recently seen as the Snake, Balladeer and Narrator in the Roundabout Theatre's revival of *The Apple Tree*; he simultaneously performed as the Pirate King in New York City Opera's revival of *The Pirates of Penzance*. Kudisch received Tony Award nominations for his performances in *Thoroughly Modern Millie* and *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang*. Other Broadway credits include roles in *Assassins*, *Bells Are Ringing*, *The Scarlet Pimpernel*, *High Society*, *Beauty and the Beast* and *Joseph and The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*. He has received multiple Drama Desk nominations for his Broadway and off-Broadway performances.

Kudisch's concert appearances include engagements with the Portland Symphony, Ravinia Festival and Philadelphia Philharmonic. His television and film credits include Conrad Birdie in *Bye Bye Birdie* for ABC television, guest appearances on "Sex in the City" and "David Letterman" and a recurring role on "All My Children." He appears on original cast recordings for several Broadway shows.
