



### *Leadership Quartet*

By opening up a rehearsal to the audience, a string quartet illustrates the different types of leadership skills used in musical preparation – teamwork, problem solving, negotiation, compromise, and decision-making – and shows how those same skills can be applied to academic and professional settings. The program ends with a performance of the featured work.

*Instrumentation:* string trio or quartet

*Program Length:* 45-60 minutes

*Target audiences:* students, educators and professionals; possible venues include high schools, peer leadership organizations, business and management programs, corporations, character education courses, teacher development days

*Musical concepts discussed:* rehearsal techniques, interpretation, and the mechanics of a string quartet
