

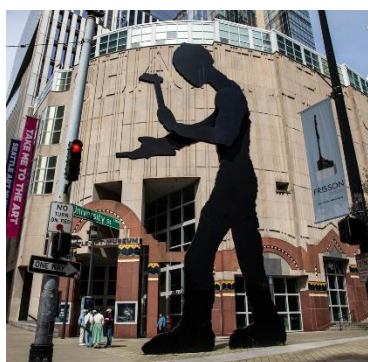
A Weekend in Seattle

- [Xian Conducts *Carmina Burana* with Seattle Symphony](#): Drawn from medieval poems that vividly celebrate the secular topics of love, lust, excess and indulgence, *Carmina burana* spans the full range of musical styles, from the power and majesty of full orchestra and chorus to the delicate intimacy of a single human voice.
- [Chihuly Garden and Glass & Space Needle Visit](#): Chihuly has shown his artwork in botanical gardens all over the world. This unique plant collection is specially chosen to complement Chihuly's work and the striking colors and forms of the trees, plants, and flowers create a rich backdrop for the art. Located at Seattle Center, the Space Needle stands at 605 feet tall and is one of the most photographed structures in the world.
- [Chateau St. Michelle Grand Estate Tour & Wine Tasting](#): Washington State's oldest winery is surrounded by 105 wooded acres and unique craftsman style architecture, acting as an oasis for everyone who visits. With all there is to experience, an hour can quickly become three. Enjoy a VIP tour of the estate and wine tasting throughout the afternoon.
