TERMS & CONDITIONS

On the advancement of payment, the payer acknowledges that he or she has read and understands the specific inclusions, exclusions, registration and cancellation policies of the tour, and the terms and conditions listed below, and that he or she agrees to be bound by them. Signature on the previous page, "Tour Reservations", authorizes payment to the New Jersey Symphony for all tour charges. This tour is sold as described; the Symphony makes no refund for unused portions.

Agreements: Quoted tour prices include planning, handling and operational charges and are quoted in US dollars.

- Cancellation penalties apply.
- Concert tickets are available only to patrons, or guests of patrons participating in the tour. Guest ticket costs are the responsibility of the patron.
- Full terms and conditions are provided to New Jersey Symphony patrons prior to booking. After booking, patrons receive a confirmation.
- Patrons should expect a detailed itinerary three weeks before departure.

Responsibility: New Jersey Symphony and its operating partners purchase hotel accommodations, restaurant services and other services from various independent suppliers that are not subject to its control. The Symphony and its operating partners cannot, therefore, be liable for any personal injury, loss or damage to person or property that may occur due to (1) a wrongful, negligent or arbitrary act by others not under direct control of the Symphony and its operating partners, (2) defects in, or failures of, any aircraft, vessel, automotive vehicle or other means of transportation not under its control, or (3) acts of God. New Jersey Symphony and its operating partners also reserve the right to withdraw a tour or any part of it, to make such alterations in the itinerary as it deems necessary or desirable, to refuse to accept or retain as a member of any tour or part thereof any person at any time and to pass on to tour members any expenditures or losses caused by airline schedule changes, delays or events beyond its control. New Jersev Symphony and its operating partners are not responsible for any expenses incurred by trip members in preparing for the trip, including non-refundable or penalty-carrying airline tickets, special clothing, visa or passport fees or other trip-related expenses.

Travel Documents: All travel documents (air tickets and identification) are the traveler's responsibility.

Baggage: Baggage handling is at the traveler's risk throughout the tour. Baggage restrictions may apply. If so, the Symphony is not responsible for excess baggage fees.

Smoking: Smoking is not permitted during situations that involve fellow travelers. This applies when travelers are in restaurants, sightseeing vehicles, trains, boats

and other water transport, air transport and when participating in group activities.

Eligibility: All travelers must be in good health. Some venues on this tour may not have elevators. Some areas may prohibit cars or shuttles, so walking is mandatory. By forwarding the payment for this tour, the traveler certifies that he/she does not have any physical or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for him/her or others. It is essential that persons with any medical problems or related dietary restriction inform New Jersey Symphony well before departure.

New Jersey Symphony reserves the right to decline to accept any person as a member of this tour or to require any participant to withdraw from the tour at any time when such action is determined to be in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the group or individual participant.

Accommodations: Hotel room upgrades are available on a first-come, first-served basis as available and are the responsibility of the participant.

Meals: All breakfasts at your hotel are included, as well as one lunch or one dinner each day of the tour.

Travel Insurance: New Jersey Symphony strongly recommends that travelers purchase travel insurance.

Prices: Prices are per person and based on a minimum number of 15 travelers. If fewer than the minimum number of travelers participate, or there is a major change in exchange rates, a price supplement may apply and/or the itinerary may be adjusted.

Inclusions: Accommodations and hotel taxes; Seattle Symphony concert tickets; all breakfasts, and alternating lunch or dinners; shuttles to and from the Seattle airport and shuttles within the hotel's designated radius; tour development and planning; on-site staff members; reservations management; and preparation and delivery of preliminary and fiscal documents.

Exclusions: All airfare; transportation outside of the hotel shuttle's radius; transportation outside of Seattle; personal expenses such as meals not listed, baggage handling, room service, laundry, excess baggage fees, communication charges; personal insurance coverage.

Airfare: Prices do not include air travel. Please contact Llundon Lawson with any questions. Once confirmed send your flight itinerary.

Registration: Full payment is required at the time you book. Payment can be made by personal check, American Express, Visa, MasterCard or Discover.

Cancellations: Cancellation subject to the following forfeit as percentage of the tour cost: more than 60 days prior to departure, 50 percent; 49-30 days, 75 percent; 29 days or less, 100 percent.
